his image and likeness. By following the Liturgical Year Calendar, we also have the amazing opportunity to read the entire bible in 3 years! (including daily gospels that are on a 2 year cycle). Starting in the new LITURGICAL YEAR please note new guidelines for placing Mass Intentions: There will be **one name (can be couple or family)** assigned to each Mass Prayer requests for the Prayer of the Faithful and to be placed in the bulletin will remain for 1 month A Book of Remembrances and Special Intentions will be set up for use in the Baptistry (All names in the book will be prayed for daily in silence during the Prayer of the Faithful). 
