

Did you know December 3rd starts the new LITURGICAL YEAR? The Catholic Church uses a circular calendar which takes us through the seasons of the liturgical year. Each day the goal is to encounter Christ. We are the clay and God, the Master Potter, uses His Word to help us grow in his image and likeness. By following the Liturgical Year Calendar, we also have the amazing opportunity to read the entire bible in 3 years! (including daily gospels that are on a 2 year cycle).

Prayer requests for the Prayer of the Faithful and to be placed in the bulletin will remain for 1 month

A Book of Remembrances and Special Intentions will be set up for use in the Baptistry (All names in the book will be prayed for daily in silence during the Prayer of the Faithful).
