



Did you know that the Altar Cloth being used at today's 11am, 25th Anniversary Mass is the original Altar Cloth that was used at the Dedication of St. Gregory the Great Church on November 6, 1999? Read on to learn the history of its creation-you may be both astonished and humbled by its deep meaning.

When St. Gregory the Great parish began building their permanent church here on Blue Cypress the idea was proposed to weave an altar cloth for the dedication. The cloth would be woven by the parishioners. Everyone would be invited to weave their prayers into each line of the cloth, their prayers would literally be laid on the altar. The loom, built by a parishioner, was placed in the worship space of our office space church so it would be available before and after each Mass. Each week the bulletin encouraged parishioners to stay after Mass or make an appointment to weave the altar cloth.

Steadily through the months the cloth grew on its tall metal frame, first the longest piece which was to drape from the front to the back of the altar. This piece was removed, fringes tied at the ends, and the loom was restrung for the side pieces. The deep colors were random for each line, each held the weavers hopes, dreams or requests, and many discovered the peacefulness of the craft. One parishioner said "You could say it was a visible symbol of the future of St. Gregory that slowly came together."

The altar cloth is heavy, which is perhaps fitting as it filled with a parish's past and future. Many who wove this are no longer with us, all of us can appreciate the community that wove it with hopes for the future. If you were a weaver of this altar cloth, we encourage you to reflect and share your experience with others.

Don't Miss the Family **Cancer Support Ministry** Meeting in November.






