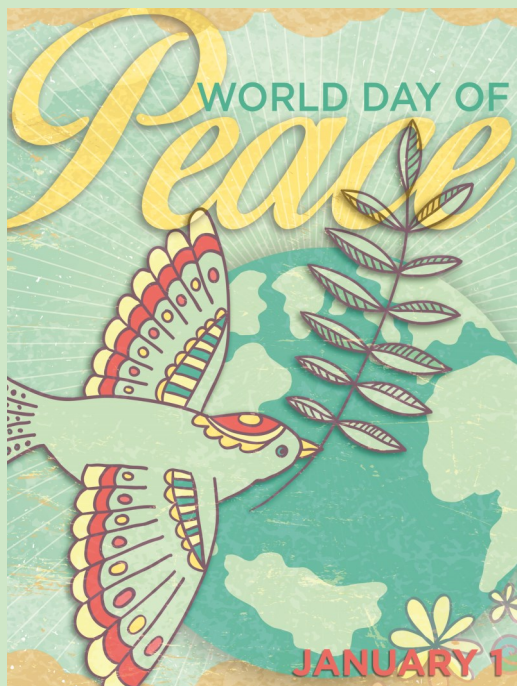

All in the Family By: Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

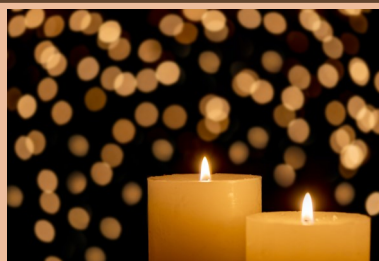
