

"Witness To Love" Program?

The goal of the "Witness to Love" Program is to help newly engaged couples connect with a mentor couple to accompany them on their journey toward The Holy Sacrament of Marriage.

Similar to a Godparent or Confirmation Sponsor, the mentor couple will be role models for the newly engaged couple. Ideally this couple would be someone they know and admire, but if the couple is new to the Parish, they will need a couple to accompany them in friendship and support.

The Mentoring process involves meeting with the couple monthly (6 months) to discuss topics guided by the Witness To Love handbook. Mentors are invited to share experiences and wisdom from their own marriages related to the topics in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere- ideally in the mentors' home.

Mentor couples say that while sharing their experiences, the process renews their own marriage too!

Look around! There may be an engaged couple sitting behind you in church right now, working up the nerve to tap you on the shoulder and ask you to be their mentors! If asked, please say Yes!

# PRACTICING) CATHOLIC – WHAT THE DEVIL DOESN'T HAVE By Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman

The devil knows that Jesus is human, so he uses all the best tricks he has for getting humans to break; Physical hunger. Insecurity and a desire for power. The yearning to appear learned and wise. The devil will try these things with us, too — this Lent, and throughout our lives. But how can we resist? We're only human. What do we have that the devil doesn't have?

### What the Devil Doesn't Have

The devil knows all the rules. The devil knows all the Bible verses. He probably knows them better than most. He thinks he can outsmart the Son of God. He thinks he can out-argue him. The devil didn't rebel against God because he didn't understand God's will. He rebelled because he understood God's will perfectly — and he didn't like it.

It doesn't work with Jesus, because, of course, Jesus is not just human. He can feel temptation, but he will not submit to it. But how are we supposed to do the same? We're not divine. We're just human.

We have a love of what the devil has renounced — those things belonging solely to God. Truth. Joy. Humility. Sanctifying sacrifice.

Let the love of those things carry you through this Lent, and beyond.
