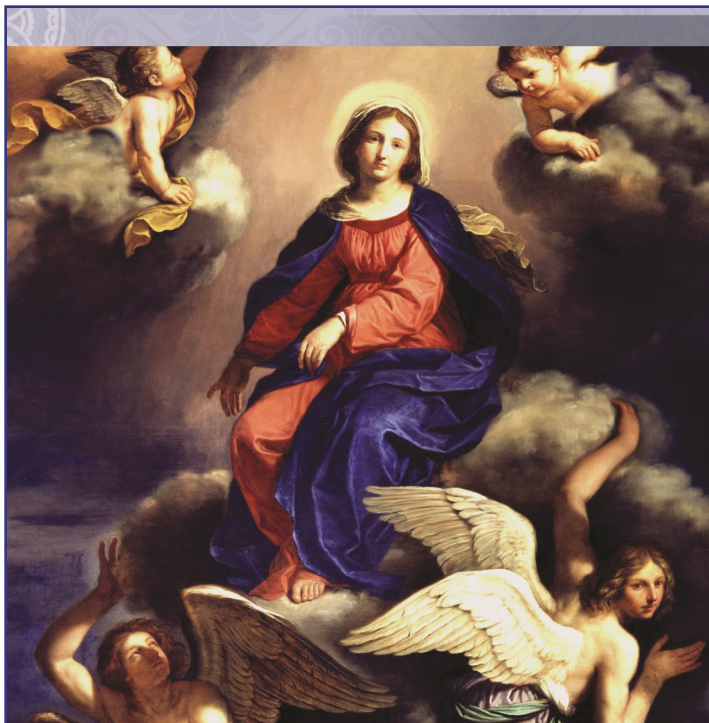

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE
Blessed Virgin Mary

This special feast celebrates Mary's passing into eternal life, when she was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory upon the conclusion of her earthly life.

Though the Church has long believed in the Assumption of Mary, the dogma was formally defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950.

The Assumption is a feast day celebrated every August 15th, and is a Holy Day of Obligation to attend Mass.

**Did you know that another name for Adoration is,
"THE HOLY HOUR?"**

Read below to learn how we came to adopt and share this beautiful practice.

A holy hour is the practice of spending one hour's time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, praying and meditating on the agony of Jesus Christ. A holy hour can also refer to any 60 minutes set aside in prayer and reflection, whether in church or elsewhere.

This devotion dates to the late 17th century, when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had visions of Jesus. The Lord requested that she spend one hour every Thursday evening lying prostrate and meditating upon Jesus's agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. This practice calls back to the Gospel of Matthew, which tells of Jesus' desire for the disciples to "remain here and keep watch with me" (Matthew 26:38) as he awaited his passion.
