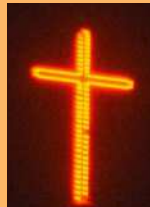

The Children's Choir will be singing at the 4:00 PM Mass on Christmas Eve. If your child is interested in

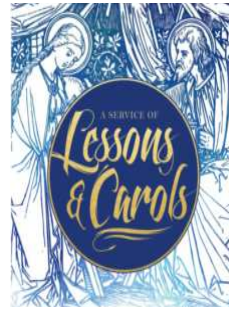
