

DID YOU KNOW?

Holy Thursday Mass will be celebrated at 7pm ONLY! (No 8am Mass)

This Mass is known as the Mass of the Lord's Supper. This is the day when Jesus shared the Last Supper with His apostles and thereby instituted the Mass in the Eucharist. This is also the night when Jesus was betrayed, arrested and tried.

12pm The Lord's Passion
3pm Stations of Cross
7pm The Lord's Passion**

This is the day, we remember Jesus' crucifixion at Calvary. He was buried that day and arose 3 days later, on Easter Sunday. All of this is done by our Lord for the forgiveness of our sins and life everlasting with Him. God so loved us that He sent His only begotten Son to die for us, so that our sins may be forgiven.

Holy Saturday Mass will be celebrated at 8pm only! (No 5pm Mass)

This Mass is called The Easter Vigil. On this day, Jesus went down into the netherworld to escort to heaven those who had died before his coming. Until this time, heaven was closed due to the original sin of Adam and Eve. We keep the vigil in expectation of the rising of our Savior, who paid the price for our sins on the cross and gained eternal salvation for us all.




