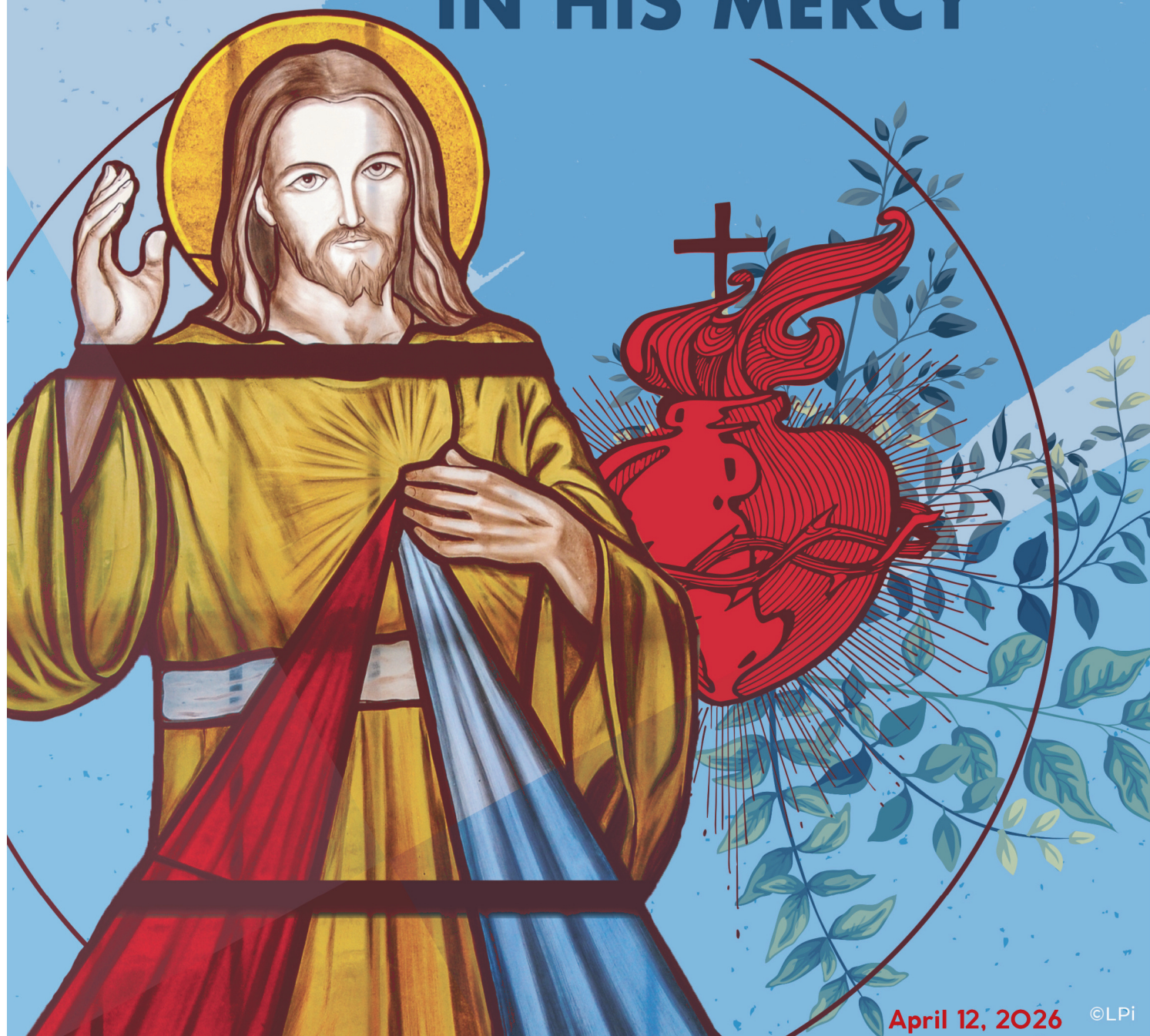

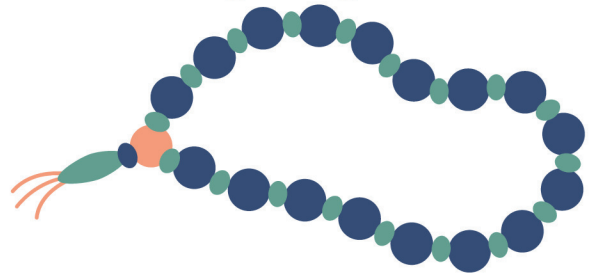

Take a moment this week to share what has been one of your most memorable dates. Pleasant reflections help keep your relationship growing strong.

Has the Catholic Church always celebrated the Feast of Divine Mercy? Before 2000, not always. In the early 1900's, Jesus appeared to a young Polish nun speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers — the Divine Mercy Chaplet — and the request to have a feast day established to remind us of the mercy of God. St. Faustina was that nun. Her diaries began circulating in Poland and it quickly became apparent that St. Faustina had a cause for her canonization to be opened. John Paul II canonized her in 2000, and on her canonization day, he established Divine Mercy Sunday, “an invitation to all Christians to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind with experience in the years to come.”
